As I said this is just about my opinion of the unit after using it on the bank and my opinion is; The unit is awesome...!!

I had done my research on this unit and what swayed me to choose the Atom over the numerous other and probably very good 'Power Banks' out there, was the fact that this unit also has a 230v 50Hz AC Output, which for me, is perfect for recharging my Li-ion Bait Boat Battery without the need for a separate 'Inverter' or Battery Controller.

In the past and for the last 25 years of French Trips, I have always taken a spare 'Car Battery' with me and even use this method of power in the UK on trips of over 24 hours. Alongside the Car Battery, I take a Solar

Panel and a Solar Charging 'Controller' to ensure the Battery does not get over-charged and that the output to the items being charged is stabilised and also a 230vac Inverter. This last trip, I just took the PowaPacs Atom.

I have not purchased one of their Solar panels for charging 'Off-Grid' as I already have a Solar panel
